REGISTRATION ADVISING: will take place from February 27th to March 28th in EB2 3006. Tentative advising hours are noted below. The most accurate advising hours will be posted on the ECE advising web site at <http://www.ece.ncsu.edu/academics/ugrad/advising/advschedule.pdf> Advising is walk-in (no appointments).

You must print out your degree audit & degree totals and bring it to your advising session to be advised. We no longer have copies of this available to pick up.

PROCEEDURE FOR IN-PERSON ADVISING: Print your ADA and degree totals off the web. Pick up an advising form (pink sheet) and fill it out. After the advisor has signed your planning form, turn in the form and your PIN number will be released to you later that day. **If you chose to be re-advised at a later time, you MUST have your ADA with you.**

TO PRINT YOUR ADA (DEGREE AUDIT) OFF THE WEB:

Go to: http://www.ncsu.edu/reg_records/ Click on "My Pack"

Log on, click on "For Students" - "DEGREE AUDIT", click on "DEGREE AUDIT" again and print.

Seniors only: Go back and click on "ACADEMIC TOTALS" and print this.

PROCEEDURE FOR E-ADVISING:

Go to: <http://www.ece.ncsu.edu/academics/ugrad/advising/> Click on "Advising Planning Form". Fill out the form and submit. Ms. Townsend will review your form and you will be emailed when your pin# is released. If there are problems with your plan, you will be asked to come in for advising. **Please allow two days for your PIN number to be released.**

AN IMPORTANT NOTE ABOUT E-ADVISING: If do not understand your course requirements, do not use E-Advising. Doing so will only prolong getting your PIN number.

TRACS & WEB REGISTRATION: Window access is based upon the total hours passed at the time of registration. **Your registration date given with your PIN number is based on hours passed and does not reflect any priority registration.** Registration dates are published at <http://www.ncsu.edu/registrar/calendars/registrationsprg.html>

COURSE NOTES:

ECE109 is the course substitute for ECE206. ECE206 is no longer offered.

ECE209 may be used as a substitute for either CSC216 or CSC316.

ECE209 & 309 may be used as a substitute for CSC216 & CSC316.

ECE200, 206 and 209 have a 2.3 gpa requirement. If you add this course and your gpa drops below 2.3, you will be administratively dropped from the course.

ECE211, 212, & 220 require matriculation into the department. If you have not matriculated and are able to do so, please see Dr. Robbins in 118 Page Hall. For an exception to this restriction, come to EB2 3006 after spring grades are in.

C-WALL COURSES: ALL 200 level ECE and CSC courses must be completed with a grade of C- or better.

PREREQUISITES: It is your responsibility to be sure that you have the prerequisites for your courses. Failure to have a prerequisite could result in your being dropped from the course.

CREDIT-ONLY GRADING: With the exception of foreign language proficiency and PE courses, all courses must be taken for a letter grade to count toward your degree.
