Filling out the Electronic Plan of Work

All graduate students, including ABM students, are required to fill out an electronic Plan of Work through MyPackPortal prior to starting their final semester as graduate students. For information about the requirements for the EE and CPE Master's POW, please see the ECE Master's Plan of Work Guide online. This electronic plan of work is in addition to the paper plan above that is submitted prior to applying to the MS program. Students who have completed credits through the ABM program must have applied to be considered for admission as an ABM student PRIOR to applying to the Master's degree through ApplyYourself. ABM students must graduate within 12 months of completing the Bachelor's degree.

Double Counted Courses

Currently the electronic Plan of Work in SIS is not built to accommodate ABM students. ABM students will use the transfer credit option to list in one line the total number of credits they have been approved to double count in both their BS and MS degrees. In the "Requirement/ Course Description" line, please type "ABM Credits, See Comment". You will then write a comment in the comment tab and list the courses, the semester taken, and the grade earned.

For Example:

ABM Courses

ECE 520, Spring 2010, A+

ECE 515, Spring 2010, A

ECE 582, Fall 2009, B

ECE 513, Fall 2009, A

Courses To Be Applied to the MS Only

If you have courses taken while in undergraduate status that will NOT count towards your Bachelor's degree, but will count towards your Master's degree, you will need to submit a [Transfer Credit Request Form](#) once admitted to the MS program. This would need to be done early, so you can correctly fill out your electronic Plan of Work. The Transfer Credit Request Form allows the credits to be moved to the graduate section on your transcript. You should also be able to pull these courses into your plan of work using the transfer credits option. Please make an additional comment on the Plan of Work regarding these credits once approved for transfer.
